February is Catholic Press Month and an opportunity to give thanks for the gift of ***The Catholic Sun***, the official newspaper of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse. We are blessed to have ***The Catholic Sun*** as it provides readers throughout our seven county Diocese with the opportunity to learn about what is taking place in our local Church as well as learn about things taking place in the Church throughout the United States and the world.

In 1892, ***The Catholic Sun*** was started to spread the Good News in our area. It was a private publication until Bishop O’Keefe purchased it in 1988 and maintained it as our Diocesan newspaper. Every year 44 print and digital issues are published. The Catholic Sun is really the only media that shares what is taking place locally. Furthermore, it offers good catechesis, it is a tool for evangelization, good spiritual articles, it connects us weekly to our Bishop through his column, and, for many, it connects us with the Universal Church.

I would strongly encourage you to consider a subscription to the Catholic Sun. In all the pews this weekend are envelopes for you to subscribe. The cost is \$24 a year – roughly \$.55 a copy. As you know you, you can hardly buy anything for fifty-five cents anymore. Please take one of the envelopes and fill it out for your subscription. 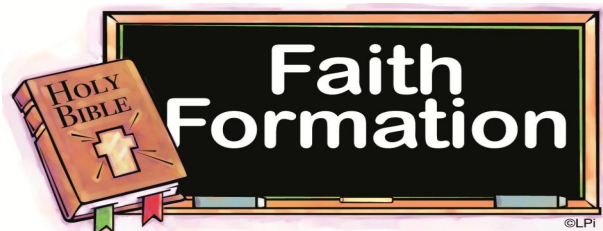
