Dear Friends,

I want to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has given to the annual Hope Appeal. As you know, the monies generated through this diocesan wide campaign, are used exclusively for the Mass for shut-ins, hospital and nursing home chaplains, college campus ministry, marriage preparation courses, pro-life activities, youth and young adult programs, faith formation programs, Catholic school tuition assistance, vocations to the priesthood and permanent diaconate, Catholic Charities, soup kitchens, and food pantries. Without the Hope Appeal, it would be nearly impossible to carry out the mission of Jesus! Your goodness to this appeal helps so many people in our seven county Diocese experience the love and mercy of our Lord.

Every parish has a Hope Appeal goal. Our goal at Holy Family is \$118,000 (the same as it has been for the past seven years). To date, Holy Family has raised \$165,368.63 in gift and pledges to the Hope Appeal. We have raised nearly \$50,000 beyond our goal! This is just phenomenal and a great sign of the generosity of our parish! Currently, 677 families out of 3,700 families or 18.3% have made a donation to the appeal. The average gift per family is \$244.00. Since we have exceeded our goal of \$118,000, all of the overage comes back to Holy Family Church for our use. I cannot tell you what a blessing this will be to our parish family.

There is still time to give to the appeal. If you have not made a gift or pledge, you can do so as soon as possible, and it will be counted in the 2021 campaign. There are Hope Appeal envelopes in the Gathering Space or just put your gift/pledge in an envelope and place it in the collection basket or send it to the parish office. To all who have given, your generosity will touch many lives. There are many who need to experience the presence of the Lord and your gift to the Hope Appeal will make that a reality! Holy Family Church is never outdone in its goodness, and I thank you for all the sacrifices you make to help others encounter Christ. Remember, God will repay us a hundredfold for our generosity!
