Dear Friends,

First and foremost, I just want to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to you for your goodness and generosity to the annual Hope Appeal. I know that it is a sacrifice for all of us and I hope you will recognize, as I do, that it is a sacrifice worth making. Secondly, I would like to congratulate you on another successful Hope Appeal for 2016. **We have met and exceeded our goal of \$117,000.00! As of today, our parish has raised \$142,287.00.** This is tremendous news and our best Hope Appeal to date. Thank you so much for your generosity and goodness. I am so sincerely grateful for your generosity. This parish is a blessing in our local area and now, throughout our Diocese, we will help many encounter Jesus Christ.

At the same time I would like to share the Hope Appeal by the numbers. Out of a possible 3,500 households 766 families have contributed to the annual appeal - that's roughly 22% of our parish. The average gift per family is roughly \$186.00. So far, we have exceeded our goal by just over \$25,000.00. Since we have exceeded our goal, half of the overage comes back to us at Holy Family for our use!

So, WE ARE NOT DONE YET - you can still contribute to the Hope Appeal and I strongly encourage you to do so. Remember for every dollar donated \$.50 comes back to Holy Family. If I could I would just like to offer one gentle, pastoral observation - currently 22% of our parish has supported the appeal and we have been successful. However, the reality is that 78% of the parish has not been heard from. Imagine the possibilities for sharing Jesus with others if more of our people supported the appeal. I would like to encourage all of those who have not given, to please give something because we know, as in our own families, that great things are possible when the whole family contributes. While it is a tremendous blessing to achieve our goal, the great blessing would be to see 40-50% or more of our parish contributing to the Hope Appeal.

Again, I cannot thank you enough for your goodness and generosity. Thank you to Phil Catalino and all the volunteers who made the Hope Appeal a success. I know and have experienced that when we are generous to the Lord, the Lord repays us a hundredfold or more!

FAITH FORMATION WILL NO LONGER BE HELD ON TUESDAY NIGHTS!

The following changes will be made in the upcoming year to improve Faith Formation:

- Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5, & 6: will be offered on Sundays from 10 – 11:15AM and Mondays from 6:15-7:30PM
- Grade 2 Faith Formation will be offered only on Monday nights from 6:15 – 7:30PM. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are taught during Grade 2 and it is necessary that your child is thoroughly prepared. It is highly recommended that, if you have a child in Grade 1, they attend Faith Formation in order to help prepare them for the upcoming Grade 2 Sacramental Preparation year.
- Grade 7 & 8 Faith Formation will be offered on Monday nights only in the church hall from 6:15 – 7:30PM. This will be taught using the EDGE ministry curriculum.
- Confirmation 1 will continue on Sundays from 10 -11:30AM and Confirmation 2 will continue on Sundays from 11:45AM – 1:15PM. There will be 3 required Masses for C1 and C2 to attend as a group and this is during a class time, with C1 attending Mass at 10:30AM and C2 attending at the 12:15PM Mass. If you have a child who attends parochial high school, it is required that they attend the second year of Confirmation but, it is not mandatory that they attend Confirmation 1. (Though it is highly recommended that your child does attend).
