**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Dear Friends,

Since the 1980's, our Diocese has been talking about parish reconfiguration. Even back then, there was a sense that things were changing and things would not be the same going forward. Some of this is due to the fact that there is indeed a clergy shortage and some of it is due to the fact that people do not go to church like they used to in the past. I once saw a statistic that has stuck in my mind - in 1968 there were 20,000 people that went to Mass every Sunday on the north side of Syracuse - today there are under 2,000 people that go to Mass every Sunday on the north side. We all know, things have changed, times have changed, and so on. The need for real, authentic pastoral planning is a real one and one we must take seriously.

Holy Family is unique when it comes to reconfiguration as we are the largest parish in the Diocese (by far). Currently, we have 3,500 registered parishioners. Our weekend Mass attendance is 4,500 or more - what a blessing! Sometimes, our least populated Mass on a Saturday night or Sunday is more than what most churches have for the entire weekend. However, while we are blessed in that way, the notion of reconfiguration or pastoral planning may not seem necessary for a parish so big - but it is necessary! The need for good pastoral planning has been made evident by the fact that we lost two of our priests. This has lead many to ask - "when will another priest be sent to us?" Hopefully, by now, we all recognize that there will not be another priest sent to us. It just two priests now along with Deacon Bob and hopefully more deacons in the future. As I mentioned last week, we will do all that we can within reason. As priests, we have to take into consideration our health and well being. I have been in dialogue with our Pastoral Council and will continue to evaluate how to best serve the parish on a daily basis with just two priests and a deacon. Have no fear, it can be done. We will look at all we have to do and evaluate. Also, we will continue to establish a good working relationship with our sisters and brothers at St. Joseph's in Camillus to see where we can work together and how we can benefit each other (this is something that the Diocese asked us to do as well).

At the end of the day, I look at all of this as an opportunity and a blessing. Anytime we stop to evaluate where we are at and where we are going, it opens us up to the limitless opportunities that the Holy Spirit has in store for us!

The following changes will be made in the upcoming year to improve Faith Formation:

- Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5, & 6: will be offered on Sundays from 10 - 11:15AM and Mondays from 6:15-7:30PM
- Grade 2 Faith Formation: will be offered only on Monday nights from 6:15 - 7:30PM. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are taught during Grade 2 and it is necessary that your child is thoroughly prepared. It is highly recommended that if you have a child in Grade 1 that they attend Faith Formation in order to help prepare them for the upcoming Grade 2 Sacramental Preparation year.
- Grade 7 & 8 Faith Formation: will be offered on Monday nights only in the church hall from 6:15 - 7:30PM. This will be taught using the EDGE ministry curriculum.
- Confirmation 1 will continue on Sundays from 10 -11:30AM and Confirmation 2 will continue on Sundays from 11:45AM - 1:15PM.
