HOPE APPEAL 2020

Just a reminder that our Hope Appeal 2020 campaign will wrap up on January 31, 2021. Thank you so much for your tremendous generosity to the appeal. Due to your generosity, **WE HAVE MET OUR GOAL!** As of Friday, January 8, 2021, 590 families out of 3,500 (17% of our registered families) have made gifts or pledges to the annual Hope Appeal totaling \$130,000 (110% of our goal). This is absolutely astounding. Thank you so much for your generosity! You are a blessing! In addition, 100% of the overage comes back to the parish for our use. Therefore, if you give a gift to the Hope Appeal at this time...all of it will come back to Holy Family. If you made a gift or pledge to the appeal, thank you, thank you, thank you! If you have not made your gift or pledge, please do so as soon as possible. Right now, 17% of our parish has supported the appeal. Imagine what we could do if 25%, 30%, 50%, or 75% or more supported the Hope Appeal. Again, thank you for making Holy Family a leader in Hope Appeal in the Diocese of Syracuse! Most importantly, your goodness helps bring the presence of Jesus and the Church to so many! God will bless all of us abundantly for our goodness to others!

Call to Discipleship

Last week was the Feast of the Baptism of Lord leading us to understand the Trinitarian baptism. The Scripture story reminded us of our own baptism, in which God's gift of abundant grace is given. Our response to this give of love is our call to holiness. This week we continue to celebrate the Baptism of the Lord with John the Baptist, who announces, "Behold, the Lamb of God." With this testimony from John the Baptist, two disciples immediately began to follow. The first followers sought out Jesus because of John's testimony and witness. As they followed, Jesus asked, "What are you looking for?" The disciples ask where he is staying and he responds, "Come and see". The "where" is not a place or building, it is an abidance to be in a relationship with Jesus... to follow him, to stay with him, to know him.... Today's scripture beckons to us, "Come and see!"

Question for Children: What can you do this week to show that you are a follower of Jesus?

Question for Youth: Andrew seemed to know immediately that he should follow Jesus. Do you have that same sense of confidence in your faith in Jesus? What helps? What makes it hard?

Question for Adults: In what ways do you experience being called by Jesus? What does he want you to do?


Year of Vocation - Stories of Call

The Scripture readings between the Baptism of the Lord which ends the Christmas Season and the beginning of Lent usually present the "call." accounts, where Jesus calls the first disciples. Jesus calls his disciples to "Come and see" (John 1:39) From the readings this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, we hear God calling Samuel, and then Samuel responds, "Speak, for your servant is listening." God is always calling us, beckoning us to be with Him. God calls us in many ways, but it takes the discerning ear and the discerning heart to hear. Are you listening for God's voice?
