Dear Friends.

In my pastor's notes this week I want to share with you something that is on my heart and something that has been in my prayers over the past few weeks. We have all heard the news of the young three year old girl that was tragically killed after being struck by a car while being walked into daycare. I have held this small precious child in my prayers along with her family, especially her mom and dad. As a community it should sadden all of us, give us pause, and time for reflection. It should make all of us turn to God in prayer and ask God to welcome this child into paradise!

This tragic event has also made me more aware of the fact that each and every day we usher children on and off our campus at Holy Family. It is a tremendous blessing to see nearly 300 young people go in and out of our school for classes and before and after school care. On nights and weekends, we have our young people on our campus for basketball programs, faith formation, and youth ministry. As beautiful as it is, I have become increasingly aware of the fact that oftentimes the driving around our campus and in our parking lots gives my heart great concern and keeps me up at night. I have been here for nearly two years now and I can say that I have almost been hit by a car while walking from the rectory to the church for Mass on three (3)occasions. I feel that many people, some of them coming here for Mass or events, sometimes confuse Chapel Drive with the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. I don't offer this to make light of the situation because I have seen cars go down Chapel Drive well over 40 to 50 MPH. At the same time, I have watched people maneuver through our parking lots at speeds well over 25 or 30 MPH and I have seen people pull in our lots and pull out of our lots hardly checking to see if anyone is around. I have seen our parishioners and school parents yell at drivers for driving aggressively in a school zone and so on. It is a cause of great worry and it should be for you as well.

In the near future we will be posting speed limit signs in our parking lots. I recognize this is not enough. So, I am pleading with you, I am begging you, please, please be cautious, be alert, go slow, you never know who could be walking across the street or be behind your car, or what could happen if you lost control for whatever reason (trust me, I am included in this as well). The last thing we want is a tragedy on our campus. As we head into 2017, let's do our best to keep safety a priority at Holy Family. Thank you for your patience, understanding, and cooperation in this matter.
