Dear Friends,

The New Year 2021 is off to a good start at Holy Family. As always, there is a lot taking place at our parish. I want to share a brief update on our school. I am so grateful to Sr. Christina, our principal, our faculty, staff, students, and families for all of their hard work and commitment to our school. They are following all of the social distancing protocols and doing so well. Please keep everyone at Holy Family School in your prayers.

Many of you have reached out to me and asked how our parish is doing financially during the pandemic. Right now, I can share with you that overall our collections are down, but we are doing okay. Some commented in the bulletin that they noticed that our Christmas collection was down. It was. Typically, our Christmas collection is around \$38,000 and this year it is about \$27,000. Remember, we typically see 7,000 people at Christmas and this year we saw only 900 due to the pandemic. Same is true of the weekend...prior to COVID, we would see about 4,500 people in church on the weekend. Now, we see about 500 on a weekend. So, it does impact the parish financially. Please know of my great gratitude to all of you for being so good to support the parish during this time. You have been most generous in making sacrifices so we can continue to do all the good things that we are doing. Thank you for continuing your weekly offerings, offerings for special collections, and holy days. At the same time, I want to thank everyone for keeping up with the capital campaign giving. You have been wonderful in making your monthly payments, which allows us to continue the great work outlined in the capital campaign. There is much left to do and I am so grateful for your ongoing goodness to the capital campaign at Holy Family. If there is anyone not able to make contributions due to the pandemic, please know that I truly understand. This has been a difficult time for many. For those who are able, please know that you can always contribute to the parish electronically by going to our website at www.holyfamilysyr.org or you can drop off your donations in the collection basket, the parish lock box outside the parish office, or you can mail it to the parish office. Again, thank you for your generosity

and goodness. We are truly blessed as a parish family.

Let's continue to pray for each other and let's pray for an end to this pandemic!

A big thank you to everyone who has donated so far to the annual Hope Appeal. As of today, we have exceeded our parish goal of \$118,000. 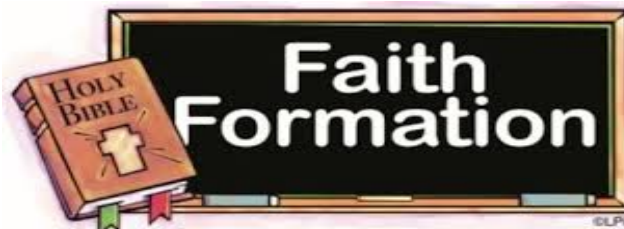
