Construction Update

Many have asked for an update on the construction of the new parish rectory. You may have noticed that the exterior and interior walls are up. The roof trusses and roof will be completed soon and then the windows will go in so as to completely enclose the building. This will allow the inside work to begin – plumbing,

electrical, heating and air conditioning, and so on will be done throughout the remainder of the winter months. The hope is that by April it will be completed so the priests can move in and then the demolition of the current rectory and parking lot work can be done. 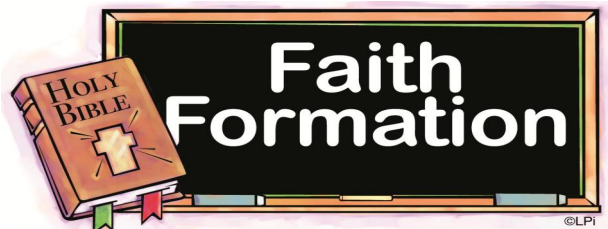
