Dear Friends,

Last week, Bishop Lucia issued a letter to the people of the Diocese of Syracuse seeking support of the Unites States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) effort to ensure that no taxpayers dollars would go for the funding of an abortion. Our president and some members of Congress are seeking to take away the Hyde Amendment that restricts federal funding of abortions in our country.

As Bishop Lucia states in his letter, "When our government offers a woman a free abortion instead of the resources she needs to care for her baby, it is not a "choice," but undue pressure in a vulnerable moment. Taxpayer dollars would be far better spent supporting women in crisis pregnancies and struggling new mothers so that no woman ever feels economic pressure to have an abortion."

As a people of faith, it is important for us to ensure that the Hyde Amendment, which has stood for the past 45 years, not be done away with. The USCCB is asking that everyone sign the petition NoTaxpayerAbortion.com by July 16, 2021. It is critical that a message is sent to the White House and to Congress that the Catholic faithful will work to uphold the sanctity and dignity of human life at all times.

If you have the time, please sign the petition. We have a right and an obligation to stand up for life. This is our opportunity and I pray that we never back down from fighting for every life from the womb to the tomb.
