I hope this finds you well and in good spirits! Please know you are always close to me as you are in my thoughts and prayers.

Just some updates I wanted to pass along to you regarding Holy Family Church.

The church will be open after daily Mass until 4 PM. This gives more opportunities for prayer throughout the day. Also, the church is air conditioned. Keep that in mind as we go through this hot spell in Central New York. Please note that face masks are required while in church.

While other states are experiencing a spike in COVID cases, we have been blessed with a low percentage of infections. However, we must maintain our diligence with contact tracing and so on. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

The final details are being added to the new Holy Family Rectory. You can see pictures of the interior on Facebook. We will be moving in on July 15. Thank you for your prayers and support.

Our weekend Mass Schedule is Saturday Vigil at 4 PM, Sunday Masses at 7:30 AM, 10:30 AM, and 4 PM. We can accommodate roughly 200 people. We have not had a full Mass since we have been back to church. Please know that you are more than welcome to attend. Someone asked me today if they could come to church. I asked why they thought they couldn't and I was told that they felt that anyone over 65 was asked to stay home. For the sake of clarification, if you feel that you are vulnerable and don't want to be in a crowd, have a weakened immune system, or if you are sick, then you should stay home. Our church is safe, it is sanitized, and it is a blessed place to be for all - no matter what age.

Live stream continues at the Saturday Vigil Mass at 4 PM and the Sunday Masses at 10:30 AM and 4 PM.

In addition, I just want to say thank you for your tremendous goodness to Holy Family. You have been so generous with your weekly offering and your donations to the Capital Campaign. I am so excited for Ed and his graciousness in saying "yes" to God. Also, keep Deacon Malachi Clark in your prayers as he will be ordained a priest on Saturday, August 15, 2020 at the Cathedral. Very exciting days for our parish! I am so happy and proud of both Ed and Malachi and wish them many happy and successful years of ministry!

JMJ**Deacon Mal's Message**

In this month of July, we remember in a special way the Precious Blood of Our Savior, Jesus Christ!

We remember the Love of a God who loved us so much that He sent us His Son to suffer and die and rise for us so that we can have life forever.

We honor the saving blood of Jesus which is the Blood which has set us free from our sins and which has won the spiritual battle in us and for us.

We thank Our Blessed Lord, not only for shedding His life-blood for us, but also for giving us his very life-blood in the Eucharist, so that our lives can be transformed in such a way that our lives and the Life of God become one—so that we become instruments through which the Grace of Christ can spread to others.

We thank Our Blessed Lord for giving us the great chance to know the great Instrument of Unity and Bond of Charity, which is His Holy Blood we receive in the Eucharist. Even when we cannot drink from the chalice, we still drink from the One Chalice when we receive the Sacred Host (since each piece of the Sacred Host and each drop from the Chalice after the Eucharistic Prayer is the entire Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ Jesus).

Like the Chosen People of Israel, who in the Book of Exodus were preserved from the dangerous angel of death through the blood of the Lamb on their doorposts, so we are preserved from spiritual danger when we receive the Blood and Body of the Lamb of God with faith and trust in the Son of God.

I would like to conclude with a meaningful and poignant passage from the Book of Revelation, which sings of this great Mystery of Christ's Blood, and what it has done for us:

“Grace to you and peace... from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead and ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, who has made us into a kingdom, priests for his God and Father, to him be glory and power forever and ever. Amen.” (Revelation 1: 4b; 5-6).

May God bless us and Mary keep us always in his love! Be Blessed and Be a Blessing!

MY OWN CHURCH

Holy Family Church is kicking off a new system called **My Own Church**, for your use in keeping up with happenings here and helping us communicate with you more efficiently! It's kind of like the Patient Portal you might be using to stay in touch with your doctor's office! We don't do telemedicine visits however!

All you need to do is visit <https://syracuse.parishsoftfamilysuite.com> and create an account.

OOPS – we found a glitch! If you are already a registered member of Holy Family, you may get a message that says your password is wrong. That's because you are already in the system but have no password. If that happens, please forward the email to me donna@holymfamilysyr.org or give me a call (315-488-3139 Ext 104) and I can “reset” your password.

Once this is completed, someone from the Parish Office will approve your account, email you, and you will be able to update your family information including names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses. You can add family members that may not have been included when you registered years ago! You will be able to view Holy Family's pictorial directory and upload your favorite family photo. Eventually you will be able to print your own contribution statements and register for Faith Formation or trips and events as they happen here. This also helps us when you need a Baptismal or Sponsor Certificate. But most of all, it will help us to communicate to all of our parishioners in these changing times!

So please, sign up for **My Own Church** today!

The Pastoral Center is temporarily open from 8:00AM - 12:00PM Monday - Thursday. Hours may increase as we enter Phase 3 - 4 of reopening New York! Feel free to call for Mass Cards and other business that can be completed over the phone. We also have a drop box mailbox out in front for your convenience.
