



Dear Friends,

Congratulations on another successful HOPE APPEAL CAMPAIGN! Holy Family Church, due to your generosity to the Capital Campaign was able to meet our Hope Appeal goal of \$118,000.00. You may remember that our Hope Appeal was rolled into the Capital Campaign so as to allow us to meet our Hope Appeal obligation.

In regards to the Hope Appeal, I have some very good news to share with you. Whenever a parish exceeds its Hope Appeal goal, the parish receives half of the overage back to use for needs at the parish. This happens in every Hope Appeal Campaign. Last year, we exceeded our goal by \$60,000.00. I was anticipating receiving half of that overage back here at Holy Family. In March 2019, I made an appeal to the Diocese and requested that for this year we receive all of the overage back from last year since we were in the midst of our own parish capital campaign. I asked that those funds from last year's overage to the Hope Appeal - \$60,000 be applied to this year's Hope Appeal. What this would mean for us is this – instead of paying the Diocese \$118,000 out of our Capital Campaign funds, which is what we were planning on doing, we only have to pay them \$58,000. Ultimately, this would mean that we would keep a lot more of our money right here at the parish. I am happy to report that the Diocese agreed with my appeal and gave us 100% of last year's overage to be applied to this year's Hope Appeal. I am most grateful to the Diocese for recognizing our great efforts in our Capital Campaign and I am grateful for their generosity in allowing us to apply those funds to the Hope Appeal 2019. The Diocese is (and has been) very supportive of all that we are doing to ensure a strong vital parish community as we go forward.

Most importantly, as we celebrate another successful Hope Appeal, I want to say thank you for your great generosity because the Hope Appeal funds so many great ministries, namely, hospital chaplains and nursing home chaplains, Mass for shut-ins, college campus ministry, pro-life activities, marriage and family life ministries, food pantries (including our own at Holy Family), soup kitchens, Catholic Charities, evangelization, youth ministry and young adult ministries, prison ministry, Catholic School

tuition assistance, refugee resettlement programs, homeless shelters, The Catholic Sun, Christ the King Retreat House, and so much more. The Hope Appeal allows our Diocese to reveal the presence of Christ to people in ways beyond our imagining. Again, God bless you for your generosity and I know that God will repay us a hundredfold for our goodness!
