This week was another historic week at Holy Family as one of our own, Edward Terzolo, was ordained a permanent deacon for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse. Ed was ordained in a beautiful Mass at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on Thursday, July 23, 2020.

Ed and his wife, Shelly, have been long time Holy Family parishioners. They are involved in many aspects of parish life and ministry. For Ed, being ordained a deacon is the culmination of roughly seven years of study and formation. As a deacon he will be able to carry out many ministries in the church, most notably, proclaim the Gospel, offer homilies, perform baptisms, weddings, and funerals outside of Mass. In addition, the deacon is called to be a man of service, prayer, and charity in the world.

I am most grateful to Ed for his willingness to answer God's call to service as a deacon. I am grateful to Bishop Lucia, not only for ordaining Ed, but assigning him to Holy Family so he can carry out his ministry in our midst. Thanks be to God! There will be ample opportunities for Deacon Ed to carry out his ministry and I look forward, as I know he does, to all of those ways that he will bring Christ to others.
