God has a great weekend in store for us at Holy Family! First, we have Bishop Cunningham here for the 12:15 PM Mass for the Rite of Candidacy for Malachi Clark. The Rite of Candidacy is the Church's recognition of Malachi as a worthy candidate for Holy Orders. In many respects, it is the last step before Malachi is ordained a deacon next year. Please keep Malachi in your prayers that he will persevere in his response to God's call to the priesthood. A special and heartfelt thank you to Bishop Cunningham for entrusting Malachi to us for the pastoral year. In doing so, we became Malachi's primary formators and helped him to grow in his understanding of the priesthood and God's call to service. I feel we gave him a pretty good understanding of what priestly life and ministry is all about and I pray that will benefit him and motivate him in these last years prior to ordination.

I want to say thank you to Malachi for all of his good work here at Holy Family throughout the year. He was involved in many aspects of parish life. He taught at our school, was involved with LifeTeen and participated on the Steubenville trip, he served daily Mass, weekend Masses, funeral Masses, and weddings. He assisted at baptisms, performed wake services at the funeral home and burials at the cemetery. He taught a class for adult education and some of our RCIA sessions. He led us in prayer on several occasions, especially on the Marian feast days when we prayed Evening Prayer and the Rosary. Most especially, I am grateful for his courage and bravery in dealing with cancer and his willingness to allow us to accompany him on that journey. As a parish family we prayed for him, suffered with him, cried with him, and celebrated with him that great news that he is cancer free! Thanks be to God and our Lady for hearing the many prayers on Malachi's behalf! As we prepare to send Malachi back to the seminary to complete his studies, I want him to know that we will continue to journey with him through our prayers and support and we look forward to having him return to share life and ministry with us in the future!

A special thanks to Mr. and Mrs. Clark and Malachi's siblings and family! Thank you for creating what St. John Paul II calls, a "domestic church." Thank you for creating a home where the faith is practiced and lived and where a vocation to serve the Church is nourished and nurtured. In this Year of the Family, thank you for your faithful witness to all of us of the necessity of making faith a priority in your family. Know of our continued prayers here at Holy Family.
