Due to your sacrifices, our Campaign total to date is nearly \$2,600,000. As you can see we have surpassed our goal of \$2.5 million! Thank you, thank you, thank you!

This week, one of our parishioners asked if the campaign was over because they wanted to make a pledge. The campaign is ongoing and pledges are still being received and they are still coming in! If you have not made a gift or pledge as of yet and would like to do so, please know that you are still able to make a gift or pledge. Currently, 24% of the parish has pledged to the Campaign and we know that if more get involved, so much will be accomplished through the efforts of so many. As of today, we are looking at all of our options for the church flat roof. A moisture test was conducted on all of our flat roofs to give us an indication of where we stand and what our options might be for our roofs. In addition, we are looking at the sidewalks in front of the main door of our church on Chapel Drive. We are in discussions about leveling off the steep incline on Chapel Drive to make it safer for all of our people. Also, new doors for the church are on order and this will allow for additional and better security of our campus. Lastly, we are still aiming for a late August ground breaking for the new rectory. So, there is a lot taking place behind the scenes and all of this is made possible as a result of the great goodness of so many here at our parish!

Know of my prayers for each of you as we go into these summer months. I pray that they will be months with some periods of rest and relaxation. Again, thank you for all that you do to make Holy Family Church “a loving family.”
