**Lectio Divina**

An important part of a healthy prayer life is reflection on Sacred Scripture. Oftentimes, this is Lectio Divina or Divine Reading. This spiritual practice invites people to read a piece of Scripture slowly and reflect quietly on those things that stood out in the passage. Then, rereading the same Scripture again and meditating on the words and meaning of the passage finding perhaps a deeper meaning. The passage could be read again a third time and then contemplating how God is trying to speak to the heart through the particular piece of Scripture. Lastly, the whole process should move the reader to pray asking God to help live out what was read and discerned through the process. This week, for practice, take the Gospel reading – John 17:20-26, and use that for your Divine Reading and see how God is speaking to you through this beautiful Scripture passage.

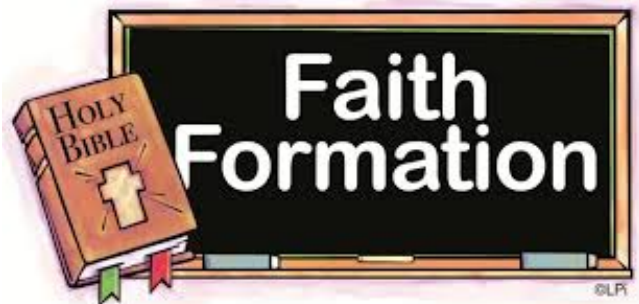

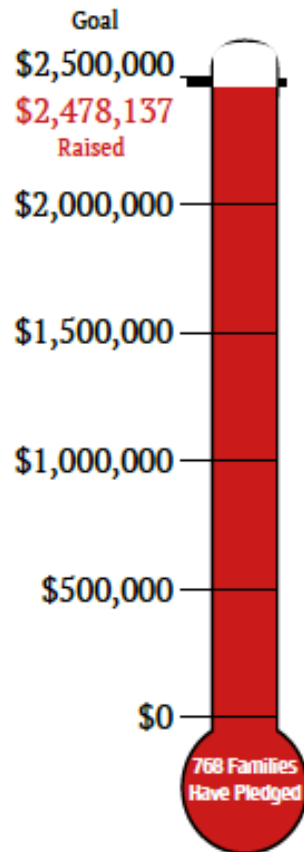
