Dear Friends,

As you know from owning your own homes, you constantly have to survey and look around to see what needs to be done, or fixed, or replaced, etc. When you have as much property and buildings as we do at Holy Family, that process of evaluating is an ongoing process. I want to share with you two upgrades to our property that will have an overall impact.

First, you probably have noticed the new fence on the east side of our property. The old lumber fence had seen better days and sections of it were in need of replacement and repair. After speaking with several fence companies, we decided to put in a new vinyl fence. Not only does it look great, but it is also easy maintenance, and it will last for a long time.

Second, since I came here in 2015 there have been issues with the elevator that we use to access the parish hall in the basement of the church. I have been asked repeatedly if there was anything that could be done about the elevator. Several months ago, we had a significant issue with it in the sense that it was unusable and the parts we needed for it were in Canada. Since the border to Canada is closed, it took too long for the parts to arrive. This put a lot of stress on our food pantry because we rely on the elevator to get the food up and downstairs. The other thing we recognized is that the elevator would need constant repairs and those repairs are not cheap. After several meetings and field trips to look at our options, it was decided that we should replace the elevator altogether. So, in the near future, the old elevator will all of its issues will be gone and replaced with a new one. The other benefit of the new elevator is that it will be serviced locally, and it will not require parts from out of the country.

I am most grateful to our maintenance staff for their commitment and dedication to our parish. They work hard to make sure our campus is well maintained and looks good week in and week out. Last weekend, a visitor to our parish, remarked

about how beautiful and well maintained our campus is! I couldn't agree more and it is due to many dedicated people who ensure that things are in good shape. Also, I want to thank all of you for your goodness and support of all that we do at Holy Family to maintain God's house!

Please know of my gratitude for all that you do to make Holy Family a place where people can come and experience the love and presence of God!
