PASTOR’S NOTES

Article I.

This weekend we welcome our Bishop, Bishop Cunningham, as the presider and homilist for the 12:15 PM Mass at the Shrine followed by the parish picnic (at the Shrine as well). It is always a blessing to have the bishop with us and we are even more blessed that he is here during the *Year of the Family*. Bishop Cunningham is the father of our diocesan family and his presence here helps to kick off a significant milestone for him – his 75th birthday! The parish family at Holy Family Church wishes Bishop Cunningham all of God’s choicest blessings and happiness for his 75th birthday and we wish him many more years of faithful service to the Diocese of Syracuse.

Article II.

Hope Appeal 2018

Do you ever ask yourself how you could do more to bring Jesus to others? Oftentimes we find ourselves saying that we wish we could do more service, help people more, and so on. Here’s the reality – the annual Hope Appeal allows us, through our generosity, to empower other people, programs, and ministries throughout the Diocese of Syracuse to bring Jesus to so many people. The Hope Appeal assists food pantries (including the one here at Holy Family), soup kitchens, homeless shelters, provides family and marriage counseling, supports family life and pro-life initiatives, provides Catholic School tuition assistance, vocation promotion, assists in training our future priests and deacons, helps provide funding for youth and young adult initiatives, and so much more. Furthermore, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family because if the parish exceeds its goal of \$117,000 – half of the overage comes back to the parish for our use. Currently, the parish is using overage from last year to increase security and technology around the campus. I am respectfully asking that each family of the parish consider a minimum gift of \$175.00 (\$.48 a day or \$14.58 a month – this is less than a pack of gum or a cup of coffee a day). If you can afford more than the minimum gift, please give what you are able. If you cannot afford the minimum gift, please give what you can as every gift counts. St. Theresa of Calcutta (Mother Theresa) once said that in the final judgment, when she stood before God, she hoped that God would thank her for her generosity and for giving of herself to help others. Through our generosity to the Hope Appeal we can help others and we know God will thank us over and over in this life and, we pray, in the life to come for our goodness! Thank you for your generous giving to the annual Hope Appeal.
