Dear Friends,

So often I ask myself how I can do more to bring the presence of Jesus to others. I find (and you probably do too) that there is not enough time in the day to do all the things I would like to do to help others experience the love and presence of our Lord. However, one of the things I know I can do is empower other people in this effort to bring our Lord to others through my generous gift to the Hope Appeal.

The Hope Appeal in the Diocese of Syracuse supports so many wonderful programs and it truly brings the presence of God to many. For example, the Hope Appeal funds soup kitchens, food pantries, tuition assistance at our Catholic Schools, college chaplains, prison chaplains, hospital and nursing home chaplains, Mass for the shut-ins (which many of our home bound parishioners watch), supports youth ministry, faith formation, evangelization efforts throughout the diocese, vocation promotion, seminarian formation, and the great work of Catholic Charities (just to name a few). Without our support, many of these services would not exist. Imagine our young people going off to college and not having access to a Newman Center or even a Catholic presence. Imagine going to the hospital and there is no chaplain to pray with us or bring Holy Communion. These works are so important and so needed.

Every parish in the Diocese of Syracuse has a Hope Appeal assessment. Our assessment at Holy Family is \$117,000.00 - it is the same assessment we have had for the past several years. In an effort to meet our assessment, I am asking every family to consider a minimum gift of \$175.00 (\$14.58 a month or \$.48 a day). I know I am asking you to make a sacrifice and I want you to know that I would never ask you to do something that I would not do. The priests of our diocese make an average gift to the Hope Appeal in the amount of \$717.00 per priest. I have already pledged \$2,500.00 to the Hope Appeal. This is a sacrifice for me, but a sacrifice I wholeheartedly believe is worthwhile. If you cannot afford the minimum gift, give what you can - every gift helps. If you can afford more, I ask you to give generously. Last year only 23% of our parish supported the Hope Appeal and we met our goal and exceeded it. Imagine if 50% of our parish supported the Hope Appeal. Also, if we exceed our goal, half of the overage comes back to us to use here. So, **a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family!**

Thank you for your generosity and goodness. Remember, God will repay us a hundredfold for our goodness.

Women of all reproductive ages are encouraged to explore this system as a means of better understanding and monitoring their own health as well as appreciating the great gift of their fertility. For couples, it is an effective and fulfilling means of building their families in a manner that is in complete conformity with Catholic Church teaching. (Method effectiveness rate for avoiding pregnancy is 99.5%, and success rates for overcoming infertility are equal to or greater than that of In Vitro Fertilization.) Free Introductory Sessions of the Creighton Model Fertility Care System are held every second Tuesday of the month at Holy Family Parish (127 Chapel Drive, Syracuse NY) from September through May and by appointment June through August.
