Emergencies at Holy Family

It is a normal experience in any parish to receive a number of emergency calls, where a priest is needed for anointing of the sick. If you find yourself or a loved one in need of the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, please do not wait until last possible minute to receive the sacrament. If you are going in for surgery, please let one of the priests know before or after Mass and they can anoint you. If you or a loved one is at home, please call the parish office so the priests can offer that sacrament at your home. If you or a loved one is admitted to the hospital, let them know you belong to Holy Family. Our priests are at the hospitals every week. Please be mindful of the fact that there are only two priests at Holy Family. If you make a call they may not be able to respond right away as they may be at Mass, a funeral, dealing with another emergency, and so on. They will get back to you as soon as possible. If you or a loved one is in a hospital or nursing home and a priest from Holy Family is not available right away, there are chaplains that they can call for those purposes. Thank you for your understanding.
