Dear Friends,

As Lent comes to a close, I want to thank everyone for your goodness in participating in all of the events and services we held during Lent. All of these events and prayer services (Fr. Jason's Adult Faith Formation Series, our Evening of Mercy, Lenten Penance Service, Catholic Date Night, Stations of the Cross) helped us to grow in our faith.

I am grateful for the great many people that attended the Stations of the Cross. It was beautiful to pray the Way of the Cross, sometimes with as many as 200 people. You may have noticed this year that the time was changed from 7:00 PM to 5:30 PM. This was done to accommodate many of our parishioners that do not like to come out when it is dark outside as well as our parishioners who shared that it was easier to come to church right from work. As a result, I am told that we had many more people participate. Another change you noticed was that we did not have Benediction at the end of the Stations of the Cross. The reason for this is that Benediction should only be done when there is a period of adoration beforehand (the period of adoration should be of some length, not just a few moments). Again, I am most grateful for the many people who participated in the Way of the Cross and the many people who expressed how touched they were during that time of prayer.

Lastly, please note our Easter Mass Schedule - Holy Saturday Easter Vigil is at 8 PM - not 5 PM (there are no confessions at 3:30 PM). Masses on Easter Sunday morning are as usual 7:30, 8:45, 10:30 AM and 12:15 PM. There is no 4 PM Mass on Easter Sunday afternoon. In the past, I am told, that the attendance is very low at that Mass as most people are enjoying their Easter dinner. Please make note that there is no Mass at 4 PM on Easter Sunday.

As we head into Holy Week, please be assured of my prayers for a holy and blessed week that gives way to the beauty and the glory of Easter!

During the week of Easter it will be offered after the 9 AM daily Mass. As we make this novena, let's pray asking God to open our hearts to God's love and mercy so generously given to us.
