Dear Friends,

Happy Holy Week! Our Palm Sunday celebrations lead us into the beauty of this sacred time of year. Thanks be to God, we are able to have our Masses and services during Holy Week in-person (and online for those who do not feel comfortable attending in-person).

By way of reminder our schedule for Holy Week is as follows:

Holy Monday – Confessions from 4 PM – 6:30 PM

Holy Thursday – No morning Mass – Mass of the Lord’s Supper at 6 PM and adoration to follow until 11 PM.

Good Friday – Commemoration of the Lord’s Passion at 3 PM – the Church will be open to 7 PM for private, quiet prayer. There will be no Stations of the Cross.

Holy Saturday – Blessing of the Easter Food at 10 AM and Easter Vigil at 8 PM – please note that there is no 4 PM Mass on Holy Saturday

Easter Sunday – Sunrise Mass at the Shrine at 6 AM, Masses in Church at 7:30 AM and 10:30 AM

You do not have to pre-register for any of these Masses or services. There will be additional seating in the parish center and the Mass will be broadcast there.

Let’s do all we can to make this week a sacred week that helps us to celebrate joyfully the resurrection of our Lord.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on June 19, 2020, The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York, ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The Bankruptcy Court has established April 15, 2021 at 11:59p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "Bar Date").

If you have a claim against the Diocese including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date with Stretto, the appointed Claims Agent.
