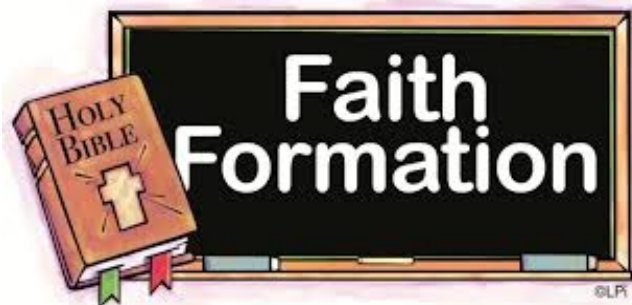

Eligibility Requirements:

Men wishing to apply to enter the deacon formation program (next class September 2020), must attend an Information Seminar together with their spouse.
