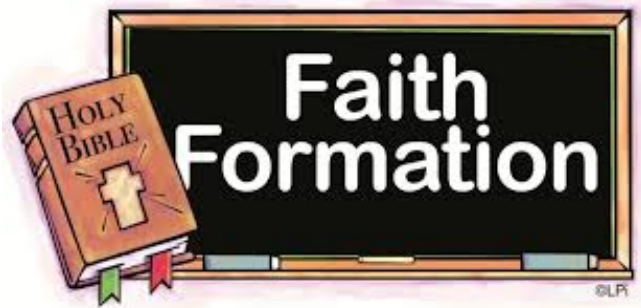

**PUTTING OUR FAITH INTO ACTION THROUGH SERVICE TO OUR PARISH AND OUR COMMUNITY**

This week I am going to highlight another ministry that we are able to support because of your generosity. It is the Catholic Charities Men's Shelter (formerly known as the Oxford Inn)

- Occupancy capacity is 99.
- Average occupancy is 80-90.
- Hours of operation 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.
- 2 meals provided daily, breakfast and supper. Supper is either a hot or cold meal, depending on donations.
- Each occupant has a cot, 1 set of sheets, 1 blanket, 1 towel and washcloth.
- All the occupants sleep in a common room with no privacy and very little space between each cot.

The men who are there have no place else to go. They are either down on their luck, or they are completely out of luck. Regardless of their situation, they are human beings who deserve respect and support. Because of your generosity, our parish is able to support the Men's Shelter through several different projects. 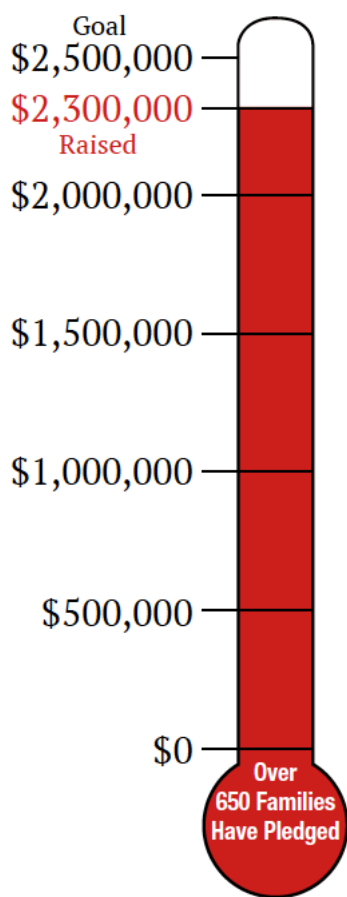
