

Dear Friends,

Many have inquired about whether priests can make hospital and nursing home visits as we are still in the pandemic. One of the things that we enjoy as priests are those opportunities to visit the sick. It has been difficult for us not to have that opportunity. However, as some of the restrictions ease, there is an openness for clergy to make pastoral visits.

It is important to understand that every hospital and nursing home is different. Most nursing homes will only allow us in if it is an emergency. If you or a loved one find yourself in the hospital, my recommendation would be to ask for the hospital chaplain to visit you. Recently, I went to one of our local hospitals and told them that I was there to see a patient. I was told that I was not on the patient's visitor list and, if I were to go in and visit the patient, no other visitor would be allowed in for the day. That means that the patient's spouse or any other family member would not be allowed in for that day as the patient is only allowed one visitor for the day (they cannot have multiple visitors). I completely understand the rationale behind all of this as the hospitals are working diligently to ensure that there is no spread of COVID-19. Again, all hospitals are different. I have been able to get into some of them to make visits. In the case of the patient mentioned above, the hospital priest chaplain went to visit our parishioner. I am so grateful for the priest chaplains that serve in our hospitals and our priest on-call chaplains that can go into the hospitals and anoint and provide pastoral care for so many people.

Please understand that we want to visit you or your loved ones and will do everything we can to make that happen. However, we do have to follow and respect the policies of each hospital and nursing home. So, if you or a loved one is in the hospital, please ask the nursing staff if the priest chaplain can make a visit and ask if your parish

priest can make a visit. In all situations, please call the parish office (315)488-3139 to let us know you or a loved one has been admitted to the hospital so we can offer our prayers. If you do obtain permission for a priest from Holy Family to make a visit, please let us know that as well.

Be assured of my prayers! As a family of faith, let's be sure to pray for all who are sick and ask our Divine Physician to provide all who are ill with love, comfort, and healing.
