Thank you for your great goodness to Holy Family’s Capital Campaign! To date, parishioners have pledged \$2.4 million, just shy of our \$2.5 million goal. Because of your generosity, we will begin to do some of the work outlined in the campaign. Currently, we have quotes from several roofing contractors for the church flat roof. We are weighing out the best option for our needs and will look to begin that work in June 2019. In addition to that, we are looking into replacing some of the sidewalks, especially the area in front of the main door of the church and, it is our hope, to break ground for the new rectory sometime in August 2019. So, as you

can see, there is a lot coming up and it is all made possible due to your goodness and generosity. If you have not made a gift or pledge as of yet, there is still time to do so. As of now, roughly 20% of our parish has supported the campaign. The desire of the campaign committee is to get as many people as possible to participate. Thank you for your tremendous support and thank you for ensuring that the faith we hold dear and love so much, will be able to continue and continue for future generations!

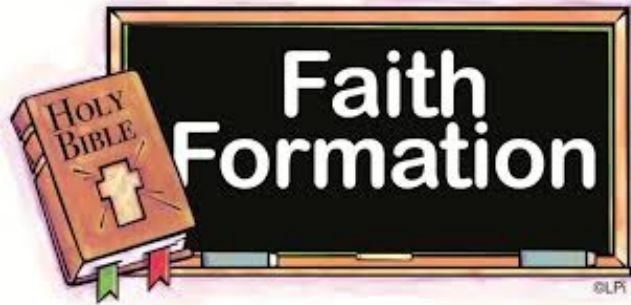

Men wishing to apply to enter the deacon formation program (next class September 2020), must attend an Information Seminar together with their spouse. 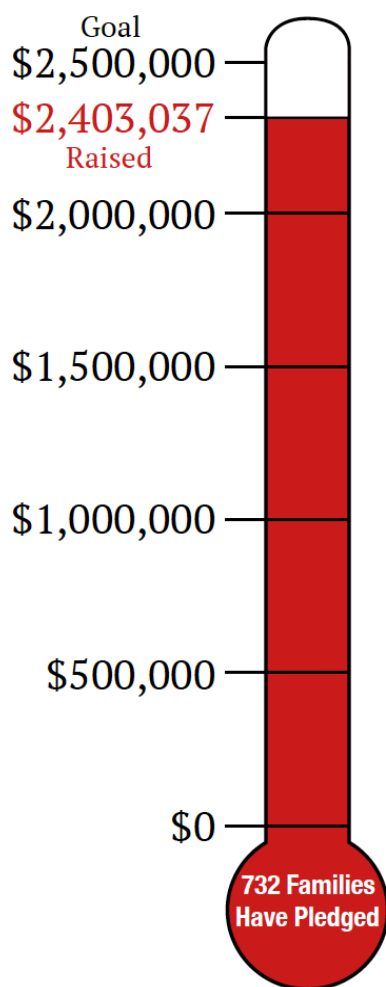
