Dear Friends,

Please accept my sincerest thanks for your generosity to the annual Hope Appeal Campaign in the Diocese of Syracuse. You have been most generous. As you have heard, the Hope Appeal helps to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ to all corners of our diocese.

This weekend Fr. Jason, Deacon Bob, and I will be sharing how the Hope Appeal monies are used in so many of the ministries that we are part of and benefit from at Holy Family. Please remember that **a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family.**

Every parish in our diocese has a goal to achieve for the Hope Appeal. At Holy Family our goal is \$117,000.00. To achieve this goal, I am asking every family in the parish to consider a minimum gift of \$175.00 (\$.48 a day or \$14.58 a month). If you can afford more than the minimum gift please give what your heart compels you to give. If you cannot afford the minimum gift/pledge, please give what you can – every gift counts. I would never ask you to do something that I would not do. I have personally made a gift of \$2,500.00 to the Hope Appeal because I know it helps people encounter Christ and our Church. Remember, if we meet our goal half of the overage comes back to our parish (if we do not meet the goal we have to pay the difference from our funds). Please make your gift or pledge as soon as possible. You can drop off your gift by way of the collection basket or by mailing it or delivering it to the parish office.

Thank you so much for your goodness. God will repay all of us a hundredfold.
