PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

It was nearly 15 years ago that I laid down on the floor of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception as I was ordained a priest. Ordination day is a beautiful day for all priests, their families, and our entire diocese. As I walked out of the cathedral on the day of ordination, it was like new birth, our Church had just ordained a new priest to be sent forth to serve. I have that same experience every time I am in the cathedral for Masses, ordinations, weddings, funerals, and major diocesan celebrations. One of the things that I am always touched by is that the Cathedral

is our "Mother Church" in the Diocese of Syracuse, constantly giving new life in various ways to the Diocese of Syracuse.

Currently, the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception is in the midst of a nearly 11 million dollar restoration. Work is being done on the roof, the exterior, the interior, the heating and air condition units, lighting, sound, and the tabernacle is being restored to the center of the cathedral as a reminder to all that Christ is the center of our lives. All Catholics in our seven county Diocese are being asked to support this restoration. Fr. Jason and I have personally been asked to give \$2,500 each because the priests support this great effort. The average gift of our priests is nearly \$4,500. As priests, we would never ask you to do something that we ourselves would not do. The hope of the Diocese is that we would make the same gift of pledge that we make to the Hope Appeal, but over a 3 to 5 year period. I respectfully and gratefully ask you to consider making your gift to the Cathedral Restoration Fund to help this great cause. It is important that all of us, as stewards of the cathedral, see the need to preserve it for the future.

Thank you in advance for your generosity and goodness. Please know of my prayers and may the Holy Family of Nazareth, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph pray for us today and always.
