ADMINISTRATOR**

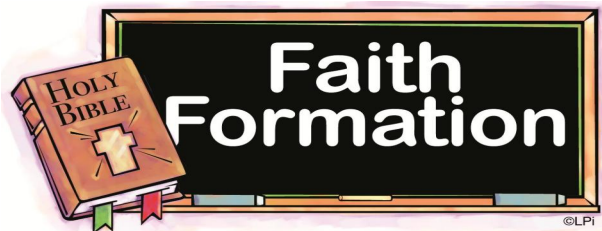
