4th Sunday of Advent: Saturday, December 23, 2017 – Vigil Mass at 5 and 7 PM (please note there are two Vigil Masses. Sunday, December 24, 2017 – Mass at 7:30 and 8:45 AM ONLY.

Christmas Eve/Day: Sunday, December 24 – Christmas Eve Masses at 4, 6, 8, and 12 Midnight. Monday, December 25, 2017 – Masses at 7:30, 9:30, and 11:30 AM.
