

Dear Holy Family Parishioners and Friends,

Did you know the annual Hope Appeal supports...Catholic Charities, Asian and Spanish Apostolates, Catholic Deaf Ministries, Social Action Ministries, Jail Ministry, Hospital Chaplains, Christ the King Retreat House, Catholic Cemeteries, Commission on Women, Charismatic Renewal, Televised Mass, Catholic School Tuition Assistance, College Chaplains, College Ministry, Evangelization efforts around the Diocese, Respect Life/Family Life initiatives, seminarian/clergy/deacon education, Youth and Young Adult Ministry, and so much more. As you can see, there is so much that the Hope Appeal supports and these ministries are so very much needed!

Soon you will be receiving information from the Diocese on how you can support the Hope Appeal. Even if you do not receive information from the Diocese, you can still support the appeal. Every parish in the Diocese of Syracuse has a Hope Appeal goal; our Hope Appeal goal is \$118,000. In an effort to achieve the goal, I would like to respectfully suggest that every family in the parish consider making a minimum gift and/or pledge to the Hope Appeal of \$150.00 (averages out to \$12.50 a month or \$41 a day). I know this is a sacrifice and I would never ask you to do something that I would not do. Therefore, I am making a pledge to the appeal for \$1,250 to support these ministries in our Diocese. If you can offer more than the minimum suggested gift per family, please do so. If not, please know that anything you offer counts. I want to be totally transparent and let you know that all Hope Appeal gifts/pledges are restricted gifts that can only be used for the purposes of the Hope Appeal. They cannot be used for any purpose outside of the scope of the Hope Appeal, namely, the Diocesan reorganization under Chapter 11 bankruptcy.

Please know that you can mail your gift or pledge to the parish office, drop it in the collection box in church, place it in the lock box at the parish office, or deliver it to the office. Thank you in advance for your great goodness and generosity to the annual appeal as it truly allows us to bring Christ to so many! I know God will bless us a hundred fold for our goodness!

Last week during a virtual meeting with CNY Food Bank, we learned of the following statistics: 15.80% of adults living in Onondaga County are food insecure, and 27% of our children are food insecure. Fortunately, there is an increase in the SNAP program to assist those in need and food pantries to provide additional help.

We have eggs, yogurt, cheese, peaches, plums and sweet potatoes to pack up for our Homebound clients and those who pick up curbside. We have been very fortunate to have fresh produce and dairy products this summer. Matthew 25 Farms has also provided tomatoes, potatoes, cucumbers, etc. We thank them for helping our clients.

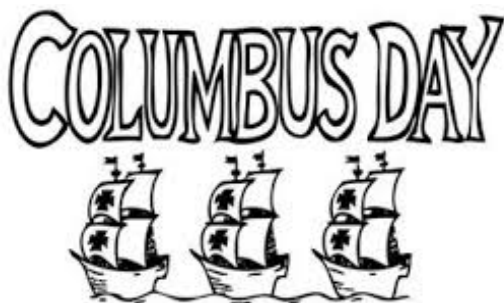

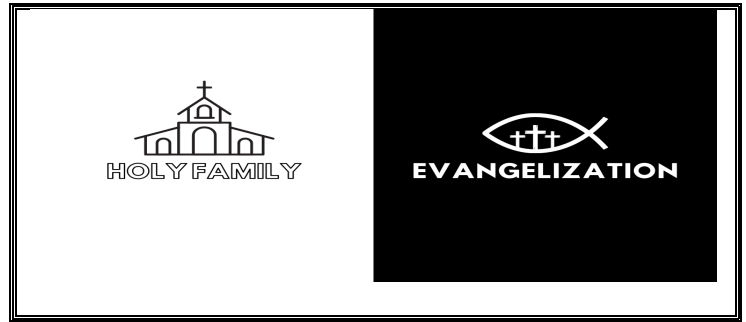
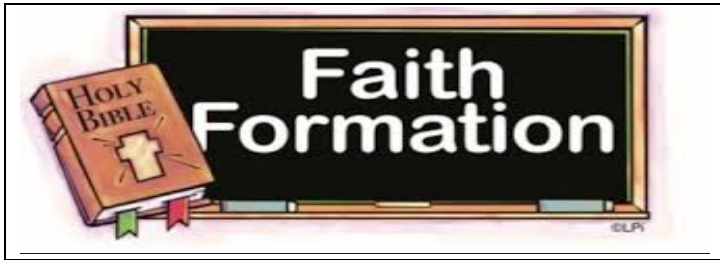
