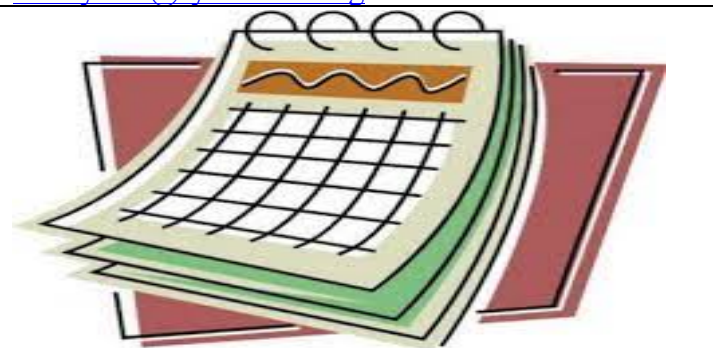
**REMINDER COVID-19 Protocols**
