All parishioners are invited to attend and join us remembering all our deceased loved ones.

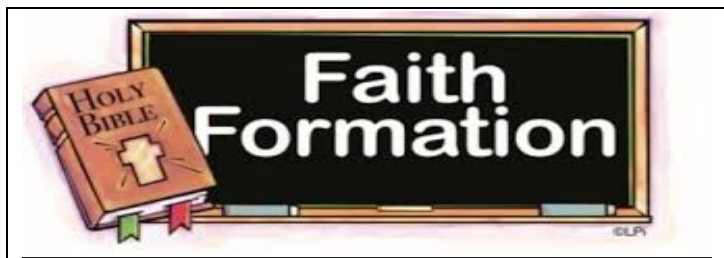
