Dear Friends,

In just over a week I will be traveling to Italy for a pilgrimage with a priest friend and 25 fellow pilgrims. I will be leaving on Tuesday, September 27 and landing in Rome on Wednesday, September 28. I will be traveling north to Siena and offer Mass at the tomb of St. Catherine of Siena, then to Assisi for the next two days. After Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis and the Basilica of St. Clare, we will travel to Rome for the next three nights. I will be returning to the United States on Monday, October 3. I am happy to make this trip during this Jubilee Year of Mercy. Please know that you will be in my prayers as I make this pilgrimage and I ask that you keep me in prayer during this time. I will pray for all of you as I walk through the Holy Doors of Mercy at each of the four major papal basilicas.

In the gathering area, I have placed a binder for you to offer any intentions that you would like me to pray for while in Italy. I will bring these intentions with me to all of these holy places. Most especially, I will offer them up for my Mass on October 2, which will take place in St. Peter’s Basilica at the altar of the Holy Sepulchre (the tomb of St. Peter). Please be sure to write any intentions you would like me to offer and know that, while you may not be able to be with me in Rome, your intentions will be offered up to God.
