Are you new to Holy Family Church?

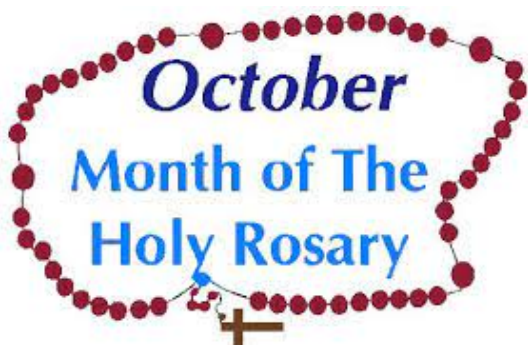
