

PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Friends,

Some of you have been asking me about the Hope Appeal and where we stand as a parish. So, I wanted to give you an update. As of today, 26% (nearly 27%) of our parish has made a contribution to the annual Hope Appeal totaling \$169,187.61. I cannot thank you enough for your generosity and goodness. Our parish has surpassed its goal by \$52,000.00. To those who have given thus far, thank you for your generosity. To those have yet to give, there is still time. Remember, I had set a parish goal of 35% giving and we are well short of that goal. It is important that you give something as everything counts. All of the Hope Appeal monies go directly to helping the poor, our Catholic Schools (including our school), college chaplains, prison chaplains, hospital chaplains, nursing home chaplains, vocation work, the Mass for shut-ins, Catholic Charities, and the list goes on and on! The Church does so much great work in our area and I cannot thank you enough for making it happen. I pray that God will bless all of us for our generosity and responding in faith to this annual appeal because, at the end of the day, our generous giving to the Hope Appeal is our "yes" to God's invitation to share Jesus with others. Thank you for bringing Christ to so many.

In other news, today I will be making a quick trip to New York City to visit our diocesan seminarians at the college seminary in Queens. We have three young men in college seminary, including our own, John Brusa III. I look forward to the opportunity to visit with them and see how they are progressing through their studies. Please keep these young men in your prayers and know that I will be sure to let them know that you are praying for them. Please pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life in the Diocese of Syracuse.

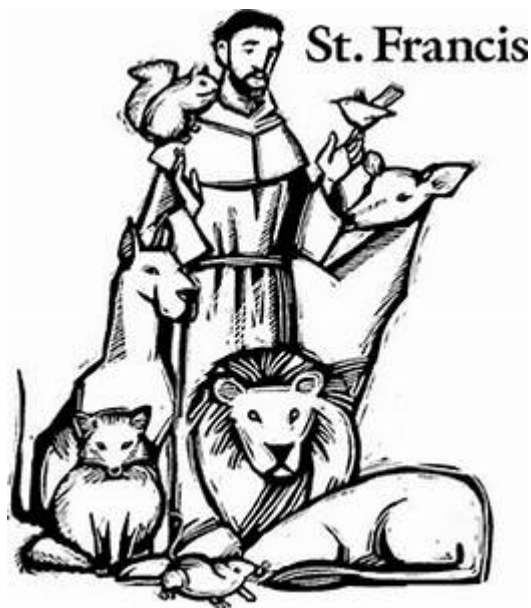

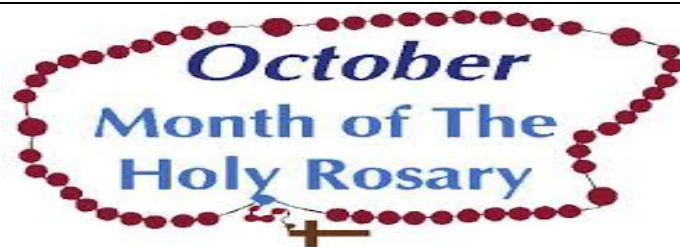
